## Global Centers

- Global Centers - hubs that link UC Davis to regions of the world.
  - Address common challenges, including UN SDGs
  - Support region-specific needs, share expertise and exchange knowledge
  - Engage the entire UC Davis community.
  - Expand collaborations and partnerships for teaching, research and service.
- Latin America and Caribbean: first region of focus; Faculty Director/Committee; 5 year plan
- Africa: strategic frame developed to inform future steps towards Global Center plan.



## UC Davis and the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

- Commitment to integrate SDGs into internationalization priorities and activities. Raising awareness and sharing opportunities.
  - Raising awareness about the SDGs/building SDG community of practice on campus
  - Supporting the next generation of global leaders
  - Engaging with partners and networks around the world
  - Tracking our progress and our areas for improvement
- October 21, 2020: Inaugural UC Davis Forum on the UN SDGs, in partnership with the Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, and the Office of Sustainability
- Working with Universitas 21 partners to create opportunities for UC Davis faculty to offer SDG-based virtual collaboration and exchange course modules with a U21 partner in winter or spring term.
