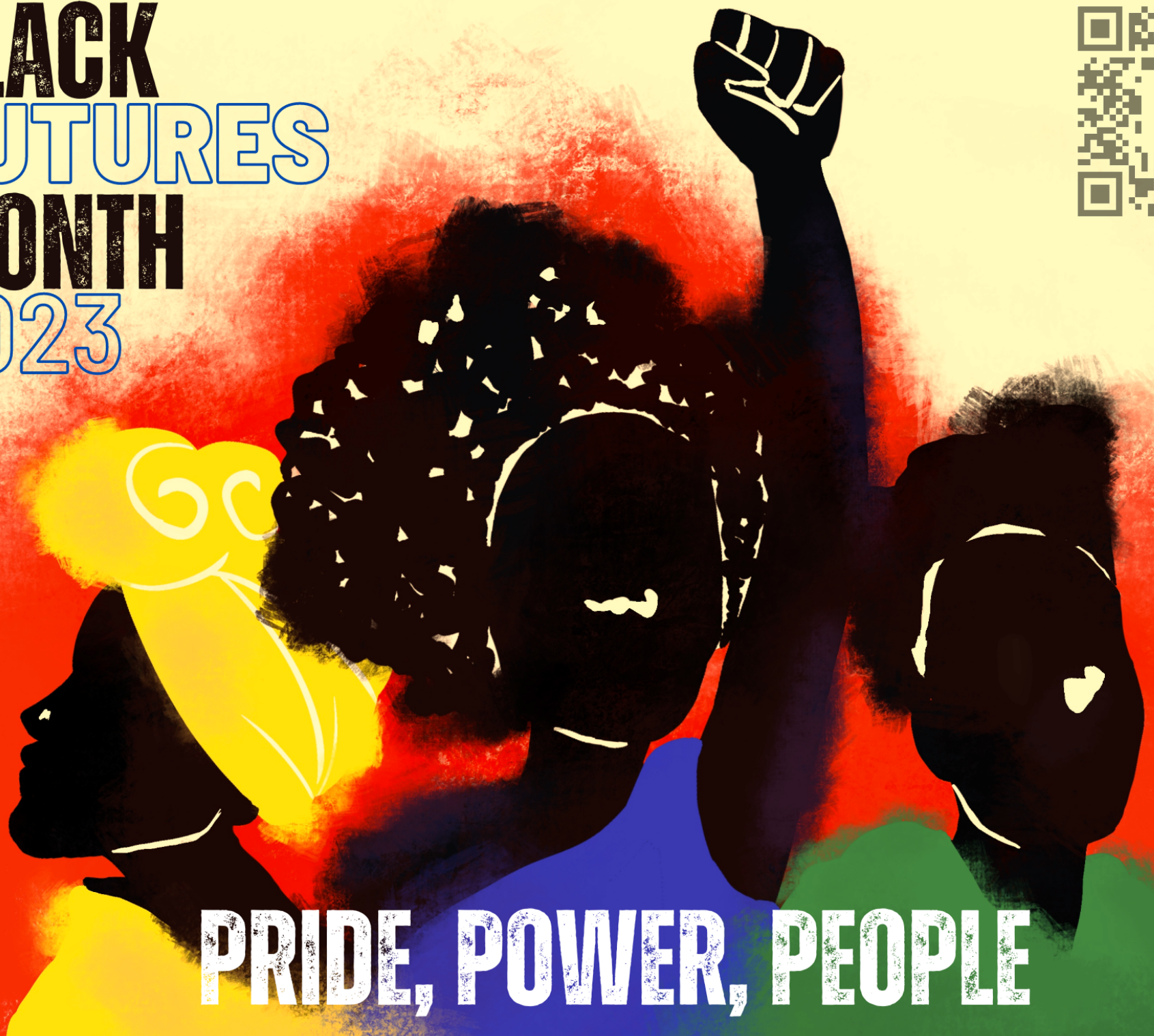


BLACK FUTURES MONTH 2023
